

Lent 2022 Bible Reading Plan

Lent is the season of preparation, renunciation, and repentance leading up to Easter. This year, we are going to read the Bible together. Our readings come from the four gospel accounts of Holy Week—from Jesus’ triumphal entry into Jerusalem to his death and burial. You will find most days have readings from multiple gospels of the same story. Some days have larger portions of Scripture than others. As you read, we encourage you to journal things like what it would have been like to be there, what the Lord is saying to you, questions you have, etc.

If you find that reading each passage each day is too difficult, pick one gospel and read its passages on the days listed. Be sure to check our Facebook page for weekly videos from Pastor Josh highlighting some of the reading for that week. And may you find Christ drawing you near to himself as He is lifted high on the cross and in your life (John 12:32).
