

Sermon-Based Group Discussion Questions

Note for the Facilitator

Thanks for leading the discussion today in your group or class. Our hope is that as you discuss the sermon today, God would lead you to consider how He wants to change you—head, heart, and hands—to become more like Christ. The questions will be the same for each message, and you can feel free to add in some of your own. Ask as many or as little as you have time for.

Head

1. Read the sermon text(s) aloud together. How did today's message clarify the meaning of the passage(s)?
2. How would you describe today's message to someone who missed it?
3. What other passages of Scripture might this sermon have brought to mind?

Heart

1. What emotions did the message stir in you? How did you react?
2. Where do you find yourself agreeing with the message? Pushing back?

Hands

1. What would change in our communities if everyone at Brenneman lived out today's teaching?
2. How might your family change if you took the lead in living this out?
3. How does today's teaching change the way you will pray this week?
4. What's one thing God is calling *you* to do this week? Be specific.
5. What's one thing you have to change in order to do this? (e.g., starting/stopping something, forming new habits, changing the way you speak, how you spend money, time, etc.)
